THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF SHELBURNE

BY-LAW NO. 9 - 1993

BEING A BY-LAW TO RESTRICT SMOKING IN THE TOWN OF SHELBURNE MUNICIPAL BUILDINGS.

WHEREAS Section 102 of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter M.45 provides as follows:

Every Council may pass such by-laws and make such regulations for the health, safety, morality and welfare of the inhabitants of the municipality in matters not specifically provided for by this Act as may be deemed expedient and are not contrary to law, and for governing the proceedings of the Council, the conduct of its members and the calling of meetings.

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Shelburne deems it necessary and expedient to restrict smoking in designated areas of municipal buildings;


NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Shelburne enacts as follows:

1. No person shall smoke in the following areas/buildings:
 - I - Centre Dufferin Recreation Complex Lobby - heated viewing area containing snack bar.
 - II - Council Chambers - Town Hall.
 - III - Shelburne Public Library.
2. Non-Smoking areas will be posted with signs in accordance with the legislation.
3. Penalty - Every person who contravenes any provision of this by-law is guilty of an offence and is liable to a fine of not less than \$100.00 and not more than \$300.00 exclusive of costs under the Provincial Offences Act.
4. This By-Law shall come into force and effect on March 1, 1993.
