

CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF SHELBURNE

BY-LAW NUMBER 43 -2004

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW 11-1999, REGULATING THE USE OF MUNICIPAL SIDEWALKS IN THE DOWNTOWN BUSINESS AREA

THIS BY-LAW is passed pursuant to the enabling provisions of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25 as amended, and in particular Sections 8, 11 and 28;

NOW THEREFORE THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF SHELBURNE BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL THEREOF ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 3 of By-law 11-1999 is hereby amended by adding the following subsections:

- (k) No person shall urinate in a public place.
- (l) No person shall defecate in a public place.
- (m) No person shall contravene any Federal, Provincial or Municipal law in a public place.
- (n) No person shall obstruct traffic. Without restricting the generality of the foregoing, three or more persons in a group or close to each other in such a way as to obstruct the free passage of other pedestrians shall be deemed to be obstructing traffic.
- (o) Upon a by-law enforcement officer identifying himself or herself and advising a person that the by-law enforcement office suspects the person of having contravened any provisions of this section, the person shall identify himself or herself to the by-law enforcement officer.
