

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF SHELBURNE

BY-LAW NO. 10-2006

Being a Intermittent or Short Term Sales By-law to Amend By-law 11-2001, being a by-law to license, regulate and govern persons who go from place to place or to a particular place with goods, wares, merchandise or services or samples of the same, for sale and others who are not permanently established at a specific location within the Corporation of the Town of Shelburne

WHEREAS the Municipal Act 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25 as amended, Part IV, Section 150 152 and 158 allows the municipality the power to license, regulate and govern a business;

NOW THEREFORE The Corporation of the Town of Shelburne by its Council enacts the following :

1. In this by-law “intermittent or short term sales ” refers to By-law 11-2001.
2. The by-law is amended by deleting Schedule A of By-law 11-2001 as referred to in section 3 (2) and inserting the attached Schedule A
3. This by-law shall come into force and be effect upon its passing.

READ A FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL, AND FINALLY PASSED THIS 13th DAY OF FEBRUARY, 2006.

“Schedule A”

By-law No. 10-2006

The rate or fee for an intermittent or short term sales license shall be as follows:

A) \$300.00 for residents

B) \$600.00 for non residents

C) Nil for local service clubs

D) Nil for participants in the Shelburne BIA Farmers Market
