

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF SHELBURNE

BY-LAW NUMBER 30-2007

Being a Intermittent or Short Term Sales By-law to Amend By-law 11-2001, being a by-law to license, regulate and govern persons who go from place to place or to a particular place with goods, wares, merchandise or services or samples of the same, for sale and others who are not permanently established at a specific location within the Corporation of the Town of Shelburne

WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Shelburne deems it expedient to amend the Intermittent or Short Term Sales By-law Number 11-2001 as amended;

AND WHEREAS By-law Number 11-2001 as amended regulates intermittent and short term sales within the Town limits of The Corporation of the Town of Shelburne;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Shelburne enacts the following:

- 1. By adding the following wording under Section 2 of By-law No. 11-2001 concerning Daily Special Event Vendor Licenses:**
 - a) That during significant community events such as Fiddle Weekend or Street Festival, the Corporation of the Town of Shelburne will regulate a Daily Special Event Vendor License. This license will not require Council approval but will require approval from the Town Clerk by signature of each application and signing a license for the daily vendor license.
 - b) That said license will be provided at no charge to established businesses within the Town of Shelburne including those with annual valid Intermittent or Short Term license based on their goods and wares providing their approvals and conditions of the license remain in force.
 - c) All other businesses seeking to conduct business during these significant community events will be charged a \$100 permit fee payable to the Town of Shelburne and available by completing the application identified as Application for Daily Special Event Vendor License.
 - d) The Town of Shelburne holds the right to designate areas for vendors and restrict use of Town property and sidewalks at their discretion.
 - e) All vendors without these permits are subject to the same penalties for violations as outlined in By-law 11-2001 as amended.
- 2. By amending Section 2.(3) of By-law No. 11-2001 and adding “to allow sound amplification in particular cases as authorized and identified as a condition in the license by the Town of Shelburne; and further that the sound amplification will be restricted to the provisions of Table 3 of By-law No.45-2004 ”**
- 3. By deleting Section 3(2) and adding that all license fees will be applicable as outlined and amended from time to time in By-law 4-2006 with the exception of licensing fees for all Shelburne based Service Clubs and the BIA Farmers market.**
- 4. And further that By-law No.10-2006 is hereby rescinded with the passing of By-law No. 30 -2007.**

READ A FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL, AND FINALLY PASSED THIS 9th DAY OF July, 2007.
