

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF SHELBURNE

BY-LAW NUMBER 30-2006

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND THE TRAFFIC BY-LAW NUMBER 8-1983

WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Shelburne deems it expedient to amend the Traffic By-law Number 8-1983 as amended;

AND WHEREAS By-law Number 8-1983 regulates traffic within the Town limits of The Corporation of the Town of Shelburne;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Shelburne enacts the following:

1. By-Law 8-1983, Section 20 is repealed and replaced by the following:

SECTION 20 PHYSICALLY HANDICAPPED PARKING

1. Where official signs to that effect are displayed, no unauthorized vehicle may be parked on the highways or part of highways set out in Column 1 of Schedule "Q" to this By-Law between the limits set out in Column 2 of the said schedule.

2. Where official signs to that effect are displayed, no authorized vehicle may be parked on the highways or part of highways set out in Column 1 of Schedule "Q" to this By-Law between the limits set out in Column 2 of the said schedule during the times or days set out in Column 3 for a longer period than set out in Column 4 of the said schedule.

2. By-law 8-1983, Section 22 1. is repealed and replaced by the following:

1. Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of Sections 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11 and 21 of this By-law 8-1983 shall be liable to a fine of not less than \$5.00 and not more than \$100.00 exclusive of costs. Such fines shall be recoverable under the provisions of the Provincial Offences Act.

3. By-law 8-1983, section 22 is amended by inserting the following:

3a. Any person who contravenes the provisions of Section 20 shall be guilty of an offence and on conviction is liable to a fine of not less than \$300 nor more than a fine of \$300. Such fines shall be recoverable under the provisions of the Provincial Offences Act.

4. By-law 8-1983, Schedule K is amended by inserting the following at the end of the listed intersections the following:

Intersection	Stopping Traffic
Simon Street	All Ways
