



PUBLIC NOTICE OF CONSTRUCTION WORK

Hot Mix Asphalt Resurfacing of Municipal Roadways 2022

The Town of Shelburne is scheduled to complete its annual Resurfacing of Municipal Roads Project. Traffic impacts can be expected during the construction period. There is also a potential for noise associated with construction to be heard during this time.

PROJECT SCHEDULE

The project is scheduled to begin on **Monday, September 11, 2022, at approximately 7:00 A.M.** and completed tentatively on Monday, September 25, 2022. Works will be performed between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m., Monday through Friday.

Residents should be aware that this schedule is subject to change due to weather impacts and other unforeseen construction delays.

PROJECT LOCATION

The 2022 Resurfacing of Municipal Roads Project includes the following locations:

Site Number	Location
1)	Greenwood Street (Fiddle Park Lane to #413 Greenwood Street & #401 Greenwood Street to Robert Street)
2)	Birch Grove (Cedar Street to Maple Court & #129 Birch Grove to Maple Court)
3)	Greenwood Crescent (Intersection near Northwest Cul-de-Sac)
4)	Laneway (Main Street to First Avenue)
5)	Owen Sound Street (South Bound Lanes, Main Street East to First Avenue)
6)	Industrial Road (Bend near #715 Industrial Road)
7)	Royal Canadian Legion Boulevard (Northeast Corner of William Street & First Avenue)

Please be aware that temporary full road closures may occur during key components of the construction project, but care shall be taken by the contractor to allow full access to local traffic.

A map outlining the project locations has been attached for your reference.



SCOPE OF WORK

The work to be completed under this project includes:

- Milling of existing top course asphalt pavement
- Adjustments to maintenance holes and catch basin structures
- Hot mix asphalt resurfacing
- Full depth resurfacing, ditching and driveway culvert replacements (Industrial Road only)

TRAFFIC IMPACT

Residents can expect temporary road closures to through traffic at the project locations over the construction period. This includes not having access to your driveways for short durations during critical components of the project (milling and paving). Flag persons will be on site at every location to ensure traffic safety is always maintained.

At the end of each working day, you will have full access to your homes or businesses. The Town of Shelburne advises residents to:

- avoid parking overnight on the roadways under construction.
- remove vehicles from the roadways prior to commencement of this proposed work.
- drive with elevated caution at reduced speeds through all construction zones.
