



PUBLIC NOTICE OF CONSTRUCTION WORK

Sidewalk Replacements 2025

The Town of Shelburne is scheduled to complete its annual repair and construction program to ensure that sidewalks are in a good state of repair. C&G Concrete will be carrying out the sidewalk replacement work for 2025. Installing new sidewalks is one way the Town works to make the community safer and more accessible.

PROJECT SCHEDULE

Construction work is anticipated to be completed **between Monday October 20, 2025 to Friday October 31, 2025**. Works will be performed between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m., Monday through Friday.

Residents should be aware that this schedule is subject to change due to weather impacts and other unforeseen construction delays.

SCOPE OF WORK

The Contractor's work to be completed under this project includes:

- Removal and disposal of existing sidewalk
- Compact granular material and replace with concrete sidewalk
- Concrete curb and gutter repair (as needed)
- Landscape repair of topsoil and seed

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

Important: Property owners should remove items located within the municipal boulevard (Town right-of-way) to avoid damage. This includes items such as landscaping (plants and pavers), decorative objects, sports equipment, etc. If you have a sprinkler system, perimeter wire for dog fence or lawn mower, or heated driveway, please mark these items or contact the below. The Town will not be responsible for damage to any privately owned items on Town property.

Temporary Inconveniences: There may be dust, noise and traffic impacts associated with construction. The Town and Contractor will make efforts to limit impacts and inconveniences. Please exercise caution in work areas and follow any posted signage or directions from onsite crews. Your continued patience and co-operation throughout the duration of the project is appreciated.

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Sidewalk Access: There will be restrictions to use of sections of sidewalk during the work period. Sidewalks may be closed to the public for a duration of the construction work.

Driveway Access: Driveway access will be impacted throughout the sidewalk panel replacement process. The contractor will make effort to notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access.

Parking: As space is needed for construction equipment and materials, please do not park on the side of the road with the sidewalk. Please arrange to park elsewhere on street or neighbouring streets and be aware of parking restrictions on the street.
