Commercial COVID compliance blitz

As part of the provincial government's education campaign for the reopening of small businesses, an inspection team will be in Shelburne **February 25-28**.

To ensure businesses are helping prevent the spread of COVID-19 in the workplace, provincial offences officers will be visiting area businesses, with a focus on commercial businesses that were closed during the provincial shutdown. The provincial offences officers, health inspectors and by-law officers will be carrying out inspections for four days.

Businesses visited will include food establishments, stores, gyms and personal care services, among others.

The full suite of government educational supports available includes:

- Free webinars on how to operate a business safely, and comply with health and safety requirements, during COVID-19.
- A free 30-minute online course on infection prevention and control provided by the Public Services Health and Safety Association.

Ontario's Main Street Relief Grant: PPE support

The Ontario Government is helping small businesses with the unexpected costs of Personal Protection Equipment.

Eligibility

To be eligible, your business must have 2 to 19 employees and be in one of the following sectors:

- Retail
- Accommodation and food services
- Repair and maintenance
- Personal and laundry services
- Gyms and yoga studios
- Arts, entertainment and recreation

What you'll get

Eligible small businesses will get one-time grants of up to \$1,000

Ontario's Small Business Support Grant

Applications are now being accepted for the new Ontario Small Business
Support Grant. This provincial grant will help small businesses that are required to close or significantly restrict services under the new Provincewide Shutdown effective December 26, 2020

Eligibility

To receive the grant, a small business must:

- Be required to close or restrict services subject to the Provincewide Shutdown effective 12:01 a.m. on December 26, 2020
- Have fewer than 100 employees at the enterprise level
- Have experienced a minimum of 20 per cent revenue decline comparing April 2020 to April 2019 revenues (or alternate time periods for businesses that were not in operation in April 2019).

Property tax and energy cost rebates

Businesses that were required to shut down or significantly restrict services due to provincial public health measures (modified Stage 2 restrictions or, going forward, in areas categorized as control, Lockdown or Provincewide Shutdown). This provincial application-based grant provides a rebate to eligible businesses in respect of property taxes and energy bills.
