

QUESTIONS RECEIVED

Q1. Confirm thickness for posts and rail. OPSD / OPSS is schedule 40.

A: Please see the specifications on within the RFP for thickness of posts and rails

Q2. Is there tree clearing or any grubbing along fence lines or this work by others?

A: There would be a little bit of clearing a site visit may help with this.

Q3. Are bidders to submit through the Merx platform or to email bids to the Treasurer?

A: It can be submitted through either one platform both are acceptable.

Q4. Is the town able to adjust the bid form to one line item RE: Supply & install 1.5m high chain link as per specifications = 220 LM.

A: Prefer to leave it how it is formatted for pricing.

Q5. Will the town provide layout?

A: Please see page 8 on the RFQ for a general layout. <u>https://www.shelburne.ca/en/town-hall/resources/Documents/RFP/2023/RFQ-02-</u>2023---Chain-Link-Fence-at-Hyland-Park.pdf

Q6. The specifications are calling for a middle fence brace with 1-11/16" diameter. Is this a brace at the corners and ends only or is it a middle rail that is to be completely around the entire fence line?

A: It would be at the corners and ends only.

Q7. What gauge is the bottom wire? We typically use a 6 gauge galvanized bottom wire for commercial fencing. Is this what we should price?

A: 6 gauge is appropriate for the bottom wire.



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Q8. There is no specification for the tie wires. We typically use a hard aluminum tie for commercial fencing. Is this what we should price?

A: Please price hard aluminum tie wires for this project.

Q9. The specifications call for 12" and 10" footings, does that mean these posts are to be sunk in 12" and 10" sonotubes respectively?

A: Yes.

Q10. If so, are we to dome the top of the concrete sonotube footings for proper drainage?

A: Yes or put the footings just below grade and add soil.

Q11. Secondly, since the chain link is to be grey galvanized, not vinyl coated in any way?

A: Galvanized is the option no vinyl coating.

Q12. Lastly, could you provide some clarification by what is meant by offsetting the entrance to dirt bikes and such?

A: To prevent dirt bikes and four wheelers going through the park.
