

## Government: Mandatory Ontario Vaccination Passport – What It Means

#### The Government of Ontario announced

- Restaurants and bars (excluding outdoor patios, delivery and takeout)
- Nightclubs (including outdoor areas of the establishment)
- Meeting and event spaces (such as banquet halls and conference/convention centres)
- Facilities used for sports and fitness activities and personal fitness

training (with the exception of youth recreational sport, such as sports leagues, dance or swimming classes, although the exemption does not apply to youth spectators at such sporting events)

- Sporting events
- Casinos, bingo halls, and gaming establishments
- Concerts, music festivals, theatres and cinemas
- Racing venues (e.g. horse racing)
- Indoor areas of waterparks
- Indoor areas where commercial film and television production takes place, where there is a studio audience
