BYLAW NUMBER 8-1983

A BYLAW TO REGULATE TRAFFIC IN THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF SHELBURNE.

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF SHELBURNE BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL THEREOF ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1 DEFINITIONS

1. BOULEVARD means that portion of a highway, other than a sidewalk or an entrance from a roadway to a private road, driveway, or lane, between the curb lines or the lateral lines of a roadway and the adjacent property line;
2. BYLAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER means a person appointed by the Corporation to enforce this Bylaw;
3. CORPORATION means The Corporation of the Town of Shelburne
4. CROSSWALK means:  
That part of a highway at an intersection that is included within the connections of the lateral lines of the sidewalks on opposite sides of the highway measured from the edges of the roadway, or  
Any portion of a roadway at an intersection or elsewhere distinctly indicated for pedestrian crossing by signs or by lines or other markings on the surface;
5. GROSS WEIGHT means the combined weight of vehicle and load;  
Bylaw #8-1983, is amended by Section 1.6 is repealed and replaced by the following:
  6. HEAVY TRAFFIC means the use of a highway for travel or parking by a vehicle, object, or contrivance for moving loads, having a gross weight, including the vehicle, object or contrivance and load, in excess of five (5) tonnes; (Bylaw 57-2006)
  7. HIGHWAY includes a common and public highway, street, lane, avenue, parkway, driveway, square, place, bridge, viaduct, or trestle, designed for and intended for, or used by the general public for the passage of vehicles;
  8. HOLIDAY means a holiday as defined in the Interpretation Act;
  9. INTERSECTION means the area embraced within the prolongation or connection of the lateral curb lines or, if none, then of the lateral boundary lines of two or more highways that join one another at an angle, whether or not one highway crosses the other;

10. **MOTOR VEHICLE** includes an automobile, motorcycle, motor-assisted bicycle unless otherwise indicated in the Highway Traffic Act and any other vehicle propelled or driven otherwise than by muscular power but does not include the cars of electric or steam railways, or other motor vehicles running only upon rails or a motorized snow vehicle, traction engine, farm tractor, self-propelled implement of husbandry or road-building machine within the meaning of the Highway Traffic Act;
11. **ONE-WAY STREET** means a highway upon which vehicular traffic is limited to movement in one direction;
12. **PARK OR PARKING**, when prohibited, means the standing of a vehicle whether occupied or not, except when standing temporarily for the purpose of and while actually engaged in loading or unloading merchandise or a passenger.
13. **PEDESTRIAN CROSSOVER** means any portion of a roadway designated by Bylaw of a municipality at an intersection or elsewhere, distinctly indicated for pedestrian crossing by signs on the highway and lines or other markings on the surface of the roadway as prescribed by the regulations;
14. **PEDESTRIANS** means a person on foot and invalids and children in a wheelchair or carriage;
15. **PHYSICALLY HANDICAPPED PERSONS** means any person whose mobility is severely impaired or possesses a physical disability;
16. **ROAD BUILDING MACHINE** means a self-propelled vehicle designed and used primarily in connection with the building or maintenance of highways and not designed or used for carrying a load;
17. **ROADWAY** means the part of the highway that is improved, designated, or ordinarily used for vehicular traffic, but does not include the shoulder, and where a highway includes two or more separate roadways the term "roadway" refers to any one roadway separately and not to all the roadways collectively;
18. **SAFETY ZONE** means the area or space set apart within a roadway for the exclusive use of pedestrians which is protected or is so marked or indicated by adequate signs as to be plainly visible at all times while set apart as a safety zone;
19. **SELF-PROPELLED IMPLEMENT OF HUSBANDRY** means a self-propelled vehicle manufactured, designed, redesigned, converted or reconstructed for a specific use in farming;
20. **SIDEWALK** means that portion of a highway between the curb lines or the lateral lines of a roadway and the adjacent property lines intended for the use of pedestrians;
21. **STAND OR STANDING**, when prohibited, means the halting of a vehicle, whether occupied or not, except for the purpose of and while actually engaged in receiving or discharging passengers.

22. STOP OR STOPPING, when prohibited, means any stopping of a vehicle, even momentarily, whether occupied or not, except when necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic or in compliance with the directions of a constable or other police officer or of a traffic control sign or signal;
23. TRAFFIC includes pedestrians, ridden or herded animals, vehicles, and other conveyances either separately or together while using any highway for the purposes of travel;
24. TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICE means any sign, or other device erected or placed under the authority of the Municipal Council for the purpose of regulating traffic;
25. TRAFFIC SIGNAL means any device manually, electrically, or mechanically operated for the regulation or control of traffic;
26. U-TURN means to turn a vehicle within a highway so as to proceed in the opposite direction;
27. VEHICLES include a motor vehicle, trailer, traction engine, farm tractor, road-building machine and any vehicle drawn, propelled, or driven by any kind of power, including muscular power, but does not include a motorized snow vehicle and the cars of electric or steam railways running only upon rails.

Bylaw #8-1983, is amended by inserting the following:

SECTION 1.28 MUNICIPAL PARKING PERMIT means a permit to park a motor vehicle in a municipal parking lot specified on the permit during the times authorized therein; (Bylaw 5-2021)

## SECTION 2 GENERAL

Where any expression of time occurs or where any hour or other period of time is stated, the time referred to shall be standard time except in periods when daylight saving time is in effect, in which periods, it shall be daylight saving time.

2. (a) The Public Works Supervisor for the Town of Shelburne or his designate, is authorized to place or erect and to maintain such authorized signs, and signs in accordance with the Regulations of the Highway Traffic Act, as are required to give effect to the provisions of this Bylaw. (Bylaw 25-2012).  
No person shall place, maintain, or display on any highway any sign, marking or device which purports to be or is an imitation of or resembles an authorized sign or sign in accordance with the Regulations of the Highway Traffic Act.
3. The Chief of Police and the Public Works Supervisor are hereby authorized to erect or place temporary "No Parking" and/or "No Stopping" signs on any highway. (Bylaw 25-2012).
4. (a) No person who is selling or offering for sale goods or produce from a stationary vehicle on a highway shall park the vehicle or

- permit the vehicle to remain parked in such a manner as to obstruct traffic
- (b) No person shall offer for sale or sell goods or produce from a vehicle on a highway except from the side of such vehicle facing an inner boulevard.
- (c) No person shall stop or permit to remain stopped, a vending vehicle on any highway unless parking is permitted, and the person shall be governed by the regulations specified in relation to the location.
- (d) Notwithstanding (c) above, no person shall park or permit to remain parked a vending vehicle for longer than fifteen (15) minutes in any one location in any one day.
5. The Schedules referred to in this Bylaw form part of this Bylaw and each entry in a Column of such a Schedule shall be read in conjunction with the entry or entries across there from and not otherwise.
6. If any section, subsection, or part of this Bylaw is declared by any Court of Law to be bad, illegal, or ultra vires, such part or parts hereof should be declared to be separate and independent and enacted as such.
7. The provisions of this Bylaw shall be enforced by the Police Department and/or Municipal Bylaw Enforcement Officers.

### SECTION 3 GENERAL PARKING AND STOPPING REGULATIONS

- 3.1 No person shall park or stop any vehicle on any highway or portion thereof except as follows:
- a) where there is a curb on the right side of the traveled portion of the highway having regard to the direction such vehicle was proceeding with its right front and rear wheels parallel to and not more than 15 cm. out from such curb,
  - b) where there is no curb with the right front and rear wheels parallel to and as near to the right-hand limit of the highway as is practicable without stopping or parking on or over a sidewalk, footpath, or boulevard.
- 3.2 The provisions of subsection 1 do not apply where angle parking is permitted under section 9, hereof or to parking or stopping a vehicle on the left-hand side of the traveled portion of the highway designated for one-way traffic.
- 3.3 Where angle parking is permitted on a highway, no person shall stop or park any vehicle except at an angle of 90 degrees from the curb or boundary of the roadway, with the front end of the vehicle at such curb or boundary.

- 3.4 Where angle parking spaces are designated by lines painted on the roadway, no person shall stop or park any vehicle except within an area designated as a parking space
- 3.5 Where parking is permitted on the left-hand side of the traveled portion of a highway designated for one-way traffic, no person shall park or stop any vehicle on the left-hand side of the highway or portion thereof except as follows:
- a) where there is a curb on the left side of the traveled portion of the highway, having regard to the direction such vehicle was proceeding, with its left front and rear wheels parallel to and not more than 15 cm. out from such curb;
  - b) where there is no curb, with the left front and rear wheels parallel to and as near to the left-hand limit of the highway as is practicable without stopping or parking on or over a sidewalk, footpath, or boulevard.
- 3.6 No person shall on any highway park or stop any vehicles:
- a) on or over a sidewalk, footpath, or boulevard;
  - b) within an intersection or crosswalk;
  - c) within a designated pedestrian crossover;
  - d) within 10 m. of a pedestrian crossover;
  - e) on the roadway alongside any stopped or parked vehicles;
  - f) other than a bus in a designated bus stop, except that the driver of a passenger vehicle may temporarily stop therein for the purpose of and while actually engaged in loading passenger when such stopping does not interfere with any bus;
  - g) alongside or across the highway from any excavation or obstruction in the roadway where the free flow of traffic would thereby be impeded;
  - h) on any street within Town limits daily, 12 midnight to 8 a.m. November 15th to April 15th. (Bylaw 25-2012)
- 3.7 No person shall obstruct any highway. Obstruction means the prevention of the passage of traffic, but the following shall not be obstruction:
- a) the use of highways as specifically permitted by the other provisions of this Bylaw;
  - b) road construction signs, barricades and equipment as authorized by the Town of Shelburne; (Bylaw 57-2006)

#### SECTION 4 PARKING BY PERMIT

- 4.1 Parking Permits for the parking of motor vehicles are hereby authorized and assigned, as the Council of the Town of Shelburne may hereafter designate by Bylaw, at municipal lots set out respectively in Schedule "R" of this Bylaw.
- 4.2 Where a sign has been erected and is on display indicating parking is prohibited without a permit, no person shall park a motor vehicle at any time in specified municipal parking lots set out in Schedule "R" unless such person is the holder of a parking permit issued under this Bylaw or has received permission from the Town of Shelburne.
- 4.3 An application for an off-street parking permit shall contain the following information: a. name and address of applicant; b. the license plate number, make and year of the motor vehicle of which the applicant is the registered owner;
- 4.4 An off-street parking permit shall contain the permit number, current year issued and the name of the municipal lot for which the permit is issued. (Bylaw 5-2021)

#### SECTION 5 PARKING AND STOPPING REGULATIONS - UNSIGNED AREAS

- 5.1 No person shall on any highway park or stop any vehicle:
- a) in such a manner as to interfere with the movement of traffic or the clearing of snow from the highway;
  - b) in such a manner as to interfere with highway cleaning operation;
  - c) in front of, or within 2 m of a driveway or laneway or so as to obstruct vehicles in the use of driveway or laneway;
  - d) within 3 m of a point on the curb or edge of the roadway adjacent to any fire hydrant;
  - e) within 10 m of an intersecting roadway;
  - f) for the purpose of washing, greasing, or repairing a vehicle;
  - g) for the purpose of displaying the vehicle for sale;
  - h) in such a position as to prevent the removal of any other vehicle previously parked;
  - i) within 15 m of any intersection controlled by traffic signals;
  - j) on the traveled portion of the roadway other than a cul-de-sac where the roadway width is 6 m or less.

5.2 No person shall park or leave any motor vehicle on any Municipal property where by means of one or more signs, it is indicated that such parking or leaving is not authorized.

#### SECTION 6 PARKING AND STOPPING REGULATIONS – SIGNED AREAS

6.1 Where signs in accordance with the Regulation of the Highway Traffic Act are displayed, no person shall park any vehicle:

- a) on any highway in front of an entrance to or exit from any building or enclosed space in which people may be expected to congregate in large numbers;
- b) on any highway within 8 m of any fire hall on the side of the highway on which the fire hall is located, or within 30 m of such fire hall on the opposite side of the highway;
- c) within 15 m of an intersection controlled by traffic lights;
- d) within 15 m of an intersection;
- e) within the turning basin of a cul-de-sac;
- f) within 15 m of the end of the roadway on a dead-end highway;
- g) other than a school purpose vehicle in a school bus loading zone;
- h) any time between the hours of 8:30 A.M. and 4:30 P.M. Monday to Friday inclusive, on one or both sides of a highway or portion thereof which is immediately adjacent to a school.

#### SECTION 7 PARKING RESTRICTIONS – SCHOOL BUS

Bylaw 8-1983 is amended by inserting the following:

7.1 Where signs in accordance with the Regulation of the Highway Traffic Act are displayed, no person shall park any school bus vehicles on any municipally owned parking lot, or roadway without a permit for parking (Bylaw 25-2012)

#### SECTION 8 PARKING RESTRICTIONS – UNHITCHED TRAILERS

Bylaw 8-1983 is amended by inserting the following:

8.1 No person shall park any trailer on any municipally owned roadway or parking lot unless the trailer is attached to a vehicle which is mechanically capable of towing the trailer. (Bylaw 32-2016)

## SECTION 9 STOPPING RESTRICTIONS AND PROHIBITIONS ON CERTAIN HIGHWAYS

9.1 Where signs in accordance with the regulations of the Highway Traffic Act are displayed, no person shall stop a vehicle on any highway at the side and between the limits set out respectively in Columns 1, 2 and 3 of Schedule "A" to this Bylaw during the prohibited times or days set out in Column 4 of the said schedule.

## SECTION 10 PARKING AND STORAGE RESTRICTIONS AND PROHIBITIONS ON CERTAIN HIGHWAYS

Bylaw #8-1983, is amended by Section 7, is repealed, and replaced by the following:

10.1 Where signs in accordance with the Regulations of Highway Traffic Act are displayed, no person shall park a vehicle on any Highway at the side and between the limits set out respectively in Columns 1, 2 and 3 of Schedule "B" to this Bylaw during the prohibited times or days set out in Column 4 of the said schedule.

10.2 Where signs in accordance with the Regulation of the Highway Traffic Act are displayed, no person shall park a vehicle on any highway at the side and between the limits set out respectively in Columns 1 and 2 of Schedule "C" to this Bylaw during the times or days set out in Column 3 of the said schedule for a longer period than set out in Column 4 of the said schedule. (Bylaw 25-2012)

## SECTION 11 GAMES OR SPORTS RESTRICTIONS

Bylaw 8-1983, is amended by inserting the following:

11.1 Unless otherwise granted under a permit to the municipality, no person shall:

- a) play or take part in any game or sport upon a highway, roadway, or boulevard;
- b) place or install on a temporary or permanent basis sports equipment including basketball nets, goal nets, skateboard ramps, or any other gaming or sporting device, on any Roadway or Boulevard. (Bylaw 25-2012)

## SECTION 12 STANDING RESTRICTIONS AND PROHIBITIONS ON CERTAIN HIGHWAYS

12.1 Where signs in accordance with the Regulations of the Highway Traffic Act are displayed, no person shall stand a vehicle on any highway at the side and between the limits set out respectively in Columns 1, 2 and 3 of Schedule "D" to this Bylaw during the prohibited times or days set out in Column 4 of the said schedule.

### SECTION 13 PERMITTED ANGLE PARKING

13.1 No person shall angle park in accordance with the provisions of subsection 3 and 4 of Section 3, on the highways at the sides and between the limits set out respectively in Column 1, 2 and 3 of schedule "E" to this Bylaw, for a longer period than set out in Column 4 of the said schedule.

### SECTION 14 LOADING ZONES

14.1 Where signs in accordance with the Regulations of the Highway Traffic Act are displayed, vehicles actually engaged in the loading and unloading, delivery, and receipt of goods, wares, merchandise or passengers to adjoining premises may be parked during such time as the said loading, unloading, delivery or receipt is actually taking place on any highway at the side and between the limits set out respectively in Columns 1, 2 and 3 of Schedule "F" to this Bylaw.

### SECTION 15 STANDS FOR TAXICABS

15.1 No person shall stop or park a vehicle or permit a vehicle to remain stopped or parked in a stand for taxicabs other than a taxicab waiting for hire or engagement.

15.2 Stands for taxicabs are hereby authorized and assigned on the highways at the sides and at the locations, set out respectively in Columns 1, 2 and 3 of Schedule "G" to this Bylaw for the permitted number of taxicabs set out in Column 4 of the said Schedule for use between the hours set out in Column 5 of the said schedule and when signs to that effect are erected.

### SECTION 16 DESIGNATED ONE-WAY STREETS

16.1 The highways set out in Column 1 of Schedule "H" to this Bylaw between the limits set out in Column 2 of the said Schedule, during the times or days set out in Column 3 of the said schedule, are hereby designated for one-way traffic only in the direction set out in Column 4 of the said schedule.

### SECTION 17 TURNING MOVEMENTS

17.1 Where signs in accordance with the regulations of the Highway Traffic Act are displayed, no person operating a vehicle shall at any time make a U-Turn at the locations set out in Column 1 of Schedule "I" to this Bylaw while traveling in the direction set out in Column 2 of the said schedule.

### SECTION 18 THROUGH HIGHWAYS

18.1 The Highways set out in Column 1 of Schedule "J" to this Bylaw between the limits set out in Column 2 of the said Schedule, are, except as provided in subsection (2) of this Section, hereby designated as through highways.

18.2 The designation in subsection (1) of this section of a highway or portion of highway as a through highway shall not include any

intersection thereon where the highway intersected is a King's Highway or where traffic control signals are installed.

#### SECTION 19 STOP SIGNS

19.1 The intersections set out in Column 1 of Schedule "K" to this Bylaw are designated as intersections where stop signs shall be erected at the locations shown in Column 2 of the said schedule.

#### SECTION 20 YIELD SIGNS

20.1 The intersections set out in Column 1 of Schedule "L" to this Bylaw are designated as intersections where yield right-of-way signs shall be erected at the locations shown in Column 2.

#### SECTION 21 SPEED ZONES

Bylaw #8-1983, is amended by Section 17, is repealed, and replaced by the following:

21.1 No person shall drive a motor vehicle at a rate of speed greater than 50 kilometers per hour on any highway within the Corporation.

21.2 Notwithstanding the above, where any highway or portion of highway set out in Column 1 of Schedule "M" of this Bylaw, between the limits set out in Column 2, is marked in compliance with the regulations under the Highway Traffic Act, the maximum rate of speed thereon shall be the rate of speed prescribed in Column 3 of said schedule. (Bylaw 25-2012)

#### SECTION 22 PEDESTRIAN CROSSOVER

22.1 The roadways set out in Column 1 of Schedule "N" to this Bylaw at the locations set out in Column 2 of said schedule are designated as pedestrian crossovers and shall be indicated at such locations, as prescribed by the regulations made under the Highway Traffic Act.

#### SECTION 23 OPERATION OF HEAVY TRAFFIC

Bylaw #8-1983, is amended by Section 19, and 19.1 are repealed and replaced by the following:

23.1 Where signs in accordance with the Regulations of Highway Traffic Act have been erected, no person shall operate heavy traffic as defined in Section 1 hereof, on all highways, roadways, or boulevards within the Corporation.

23.2 Notwithstanding the above, the operation of heavy traffic shall be permitted on the highways or portions of highways as set out in Column 1 of Schedule "O" of this Bylaw, between the limits set out in Column 2, during the times set out in Column 3, and marked in compliance with the regulations under the Highway Traffic Act.

23.3 The provisions of subsection 1 of this section shall not extend to the use of said highways or parts of highways for deliveries to or removal from any premises abutting thereon or to ambulances,

police or fire department vehicles public utility emergency vehicles, vehicles actually engaged in works undertaken for or on behalf of the Corporation. (Bylaw 25-2012)

#### SECTION 24 ACCESSIBLE PARKING      ~~HANDICAPPED PARKING~~

Bylaw #8-1983, is amended by Sections 20.1 and 20.2 are repealed and replaced by the following:

24.1 Where signs in accordance with the regulations under the Highway Traffic Act have been erected, no person shall park on the highways or part of highways set out in Column 1 of Schedule "Q" to this Bylaw between the limits set out in Column 2 of the said schedule, unless the vehicle displays a disabled person parking permit pursuant to the provisions of Ontario Regulation 581. (Bylaw 32-2007)

#### SECTION 25      SCHOOL BUS LOADING ZONES

25.1 Where signs are erected in accordance with the regulations made under the Highway Traffic Act, the highways or portions of highways set out in Column 1 of Schedule "P" to this Bylaw, on the side of the highway set out in Column 2 of the said schedule between the limits set out respectively in Columns 3 and 4 of the said schedules, are hereby designated as school bus loading zones.

#### SECTION 26      PENALTIES

Bylaw 8-1983, as amended by Bylaws 17-1984, 12-1988, and 30-2006, Section 22, is repealed and replaced by the following:

26.1 Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of Sections 2, 3, 4, 5, 5.1, 6, 7, 7.1, 8, 9, 10, 11 and 21 of this Bylaw 8-1983 shall be liable to a fine recoverable under the provisions of the Provincial Offences Act.

26.2 Any persons violating any of the provisions of Sections 12, 13, 19, of this Bylaw shall be subject to a penalty recoverable under the provisions of the Provincial Offences Act.

26.3 Any person violating any of the provisions of Sections 14, 15, 16, 17, and 18 of this Bylaw shall be subject to the penalty provided for such violation in the Highway Traffic Act.

26.4 Any person who contravenes the provisions of Section 20.1 shall be guilty of an offence and on conviction is liable to a fine of not less than \$300.00 nor more than a fine of \$300. Such fines shall be recoverable under the provisions of the Provincial Offences Act.

26.5 The owner of a vehicle for which a notice of violation has been issued alleging a contravention of any of the provisions of the By-law referred to in Section 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 20 & 21 may make payment of the fine set out in accordance with this Bylaw on the notice of violation out of court by remitting such payment to the appropriate authority in accordance with the

instructions on notice of violation within the time limit prescribed thereon.

- 26.6 A constable or an officer appointed for the carrying out of the provisions of this Bylaw, upon discovery of any vehicle parked, stopped or standing in contravention of this Bylaw may cause it to be moved or taken to and placed or stored in a suitable place and all costs and charged for removing, care and storage thereof if any, are a lien upon the vehicle, which may be enforced in the manner provided by Section 48 of the Mechanic's Lien Act.
- 26.7 The owner of a vehicle shall incur the penalties provided for any contravention of this Bylaw unless at the time of the contravention the vehicle was in the possession of some person other than the owner or his chauffer without the owner's consent in which case the driver or operator of the vehicle not being the owner, shall also be liable to incur the penalties provided for any such contravention. (Bylaw 25-2012)

#### SECTION 27 APPLICATION

- 27.1 This Bylaw applies to all highways under the jurisdiction of the Town of Shelburne.
- 27.2 Sections 12, 13, and 19 of this Bylaw shall not, if compliance therewith would be impracticable, apply to:
- a) Ambulances, Police or Fire Department vehicles or Public Utilities emergency vehicles; or
  - b) Vehicles actually engaged in works undertaken for, or on behalf of any Municipal Corporation; or,
  - c) Vehicles actually forming part of a funeral procession for as long as may reasonably be required for the purpose of such a funeral.
- 27.3 Bylaws 788a, 15-1966, 12A-1969, 33-1970, 19-1971, 29,1974, 12-1975, 40-1975, 8-1976, 25-1977, 26-1977, and 3-1983 be and the same, are hereby repealed, or any other Bylaw which may be in conflict.

27.4 Subject to subsection 27.5, the provisions of this Bylaw shall become effective upon enactment.

27.5 The provisions of this Bylaw affecting traffic on a highway designated as a connecting link pursuant to the Public Transportation and Highway Improvement Act shall not become effective until approved by the Ministry of Transportation and Communications.
