Wildlife is a natural part of our community.

Do Not Feed Wildlife
This included squirrels, birds, or stray animals. It attracts unwanted pests such as rats and mice.

Secure Your Property

- Store garbage & compost in wildlife & rodent-proof containers
- Keep pet food indoors
- Clean up fallen nuts & bird seed, it may attract squirrels, rats, or mice

Protect Your Pets

- Keep cats indoors whenever possible & supervise dogs outdoors
- Always use a leash in public spaces

Nuisance Rodents
Rodents need food, water, and shelter. Keeping your home and surrounding property clean, sealed and uncluttered can make your home less appealing to rodents. It is the most effective way to prevent them from entering and nesting.
