## **FIREWORKS SAFETY TIPS**

- Purchase from a reliable source that sells products meeting safety standards.
- •Stay away from illegal explosives or firecrackers and do not improvise and make your own. •Only adults (18 years or over) should handle the fireworks. If you are impaired (alcohol or drugs) do not handle them.
- •Wear protective eye glasses and gloves. Light at arm's length and then stand back.
- •Near lean over the fireworks and keep hair and clothes away from fire sources.
