



NOTICE TO RESIDENTS & BUSINESSES CONCERNING THE SIMON & MAIN STREET WATERMAIN EXPANSION PROJECT

August 17, 2020

The Town of Shelburne is advising residents and businesses of the municipal infrastructure project concerning the watermain expansion along Main Street East (from the west side of Simon Street to approximately 636 Main Street East).

This project's scope of work includes the installation of a new 150mm watermain and connections to existing infrastructure along the road section described above. The Contractor completing the works will be storing their equipment and material along the northbound lane of Simon Street, from Main Street East to approximately 40m south of the intersection.

Please note there will be areas affected at times due to Contractor heavy equipment traffic in the roadway location listed above. The Town understands vehicle traffic is essential in these areas and as such the Contractor will provide traffic control to ensure safe passage for vehicle and pedestrian traffic during construction, should it be necessary. We also ask that residents to remove their vehicles from the above noted roadway prior to commencement of this proposed work.

Works will be performed at the location noted above between the hours of **7:00 am** and **7:00 pm, Monday through Friday**. There is potential for noise associated with construction to be heard during this time. Construction is scheduled begin on **Monday, August 24** and is expected to take 2-3 weeks to complete.
